## GENERAL INFORMATION

Our fabrics are made of technical fibres which need to fulfill highest demands of outdoor use. Water-, dirt- and oil-repellent characteristics are especially important functions of such fabrics.

Despite using only high-quality and proven materials, there are still technical limitations. Particularly, restrictions in using finishing chemicals (due to environmental laws) limit the performance of the textile. In return, such restrictions guarantee their compatibility with humans, animals and the environment as a whole.

For how long a sunprotection fabric stays clean and neat therefore not only depends on the textile's quality, but also on various environmental influences and – above all – how the textile is used and serviced!

If your sun protection fabric has gotten wet, it's important to roll out or stretch out as soon as possible, allowing it to dry completely. This way, mold will not have the chance to adhere to the surface.

- **1.** Coarse dirt, leaves, insects or similar debris should be removed immediately.
- $\ensuremath{\textbf{2.}}$  Stains are best removed with a mild soap solution and a soft brush.
- **3.** To remove the dirt, rub in the solution from the outer part inwards over the soiled areas.
- 4. Rinse thoroughly with clear water and allow to air dry.
